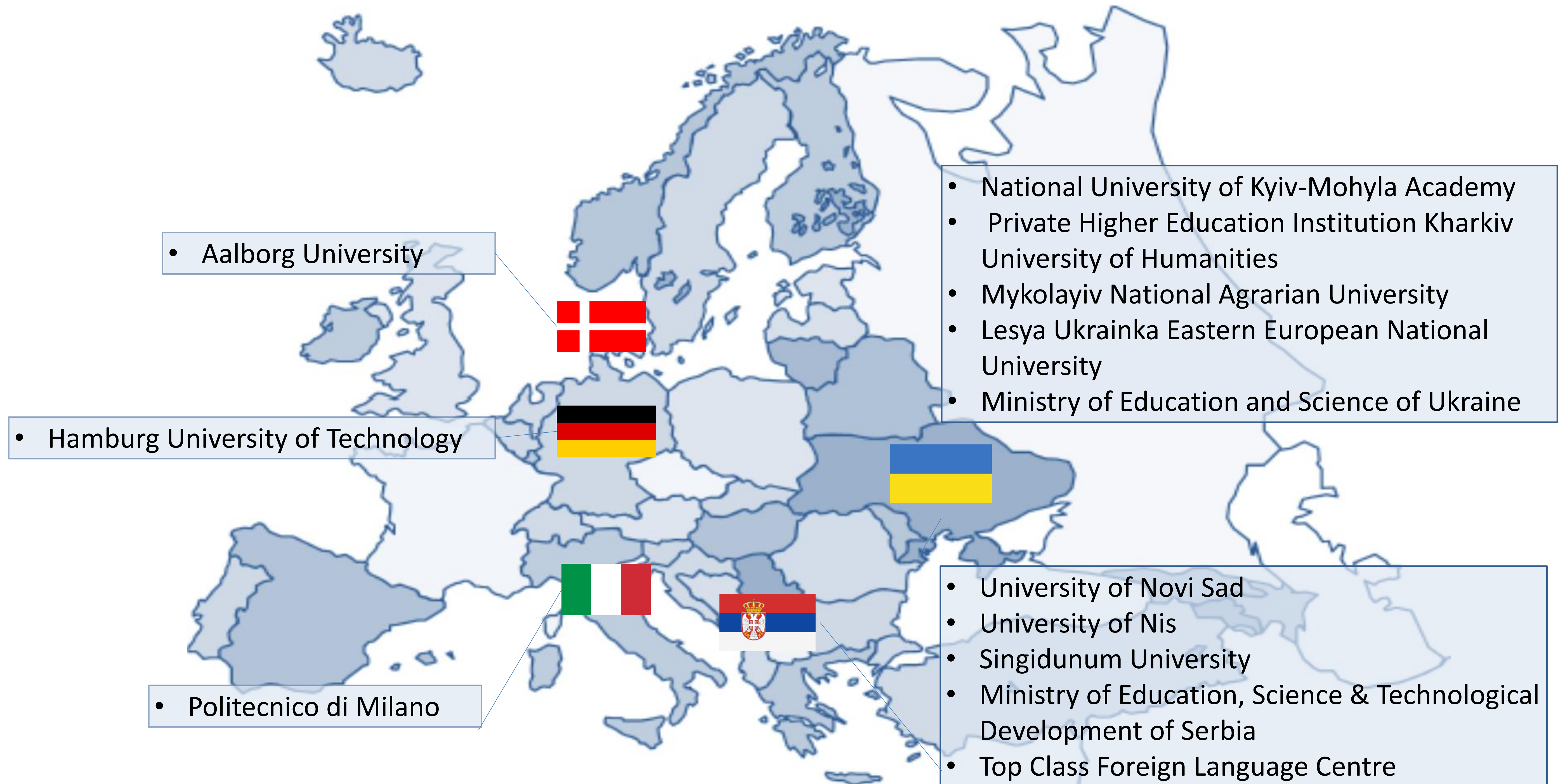




Call for applications for the second virtual mobility run



What is virtual mobility

- Virtual mobility allows students to participate **in courses and programs of other universities** without leaving their home university.
- Virtual mobility programs can be a good starting point for the physical mobility, for example, traditional real mobility Erasmus+ programmes.
- Virtual mobility allows students to promote their intercultural competencies, foreign languages skills, and skills for working in international teams and solving problems in multicultural environments (soft skills), which are increasing valued by potential employers.

About MILETUS virtual mobility programs

- For **Master and Bachelor students** from Ukraine and Serbia.
- 8 students from each Partner Universities in Ukraine and Serbia (14 international teams of students) will be selected in the virtual mobility run.
- MILETUS virtual mobility programs provide **project-based learning (PBL)** in which students gain knowledge and skills by working on the joint project.

Learning activity of the virtual mobility run

- The supporting learning material will be provided on the Moodle course website and can be accessed at your convenient time within the period of virtual mobility run.
- Students will experience working in the **international, inter-institutional and interdisciplinary teams**, together with the peers from other countries and universities, as well as looking at the problem from perspectives of different subject fields with common understanding of lecture topics.
- Students will be working **on innovative scientific topics** (joint project) under the supervision of professors from Ukrainian and Serbian Partner Universities.
- Upon successful completion of all the tasks of the mobility run (**video courses, multiple-choice test and joint project**) participants will be granted the certificates.

Supporting video courses offered

- Course of internationalization** will prepare students to work in multinational teams, improve their English language skills, develop soft skills and abilities, thereby helping them to conquer social and cultural barriers.
- Research methodology course** introduces the relevant tools of research process such as research design, research project drafting, scientific writing, etc.

Duration and workload of the virtual mobility run

- The duration of the second virtual mobility run is **45 calendar days**.
- The time spent on the virtual mobility run is splitted into the individual learning activity (15-25 hours for video courses and test) and joint project (100 hours for joint project (13-14 pages) or equal to 25 hours (3-4 pages) for individual contribution).

Who can apply?

- You are enrolled as a student in a full time **Master programme** or a **Bachelor student of 3rd and 4th study year** at the Partner Universities in Serbia and Ukraine.
- You can demonstrate a satisfactory academic performance.
- You have a high language proficiency in English (**at least B1 – intermediate level**).
- You can demonstrate a high level of motivation to be enrolled the virtual mobility run.

How to apply?

- Motivation letter in English.
- Curriculum vitae (CV) in English.
- Enrollment certificate or similar document on current student status issued by home institution (English or local language of your home institution).
