

STUDENTS' MOBILITY CAPACITY BUILDING IN HIGHER EDUCATION IN UKRAINE AND SERBIA



Students' Mobility Capacity Building in Higher Education in Ukraine and Serbia (MILETUS) is a three-year project co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union. It addresses capacity building in the field of virtual, real and blended mobility runs at higher education institutions in Ukraine and in Serbia, in order to achieve the graduates' improvement of employability chances in companies working internationally and the enhancement PhD quality of students' research.

VIRTUAL MOBILITY

Virtual mobility (VM) allows students to participate in courses and programs of other universities without leaving their home university.

- > VM programs are especially targeted to students who, for any reason, can't participate in the traditional exchange programs. These can also be a good starting for point physical/real mobility.
- > MILETUS VM programs provide project-based learning in which students acquire knowledge and skills by working on joint projects.
- > Participants gain experience in working/studying & problemsolving English, in within international and interdisciplinary teams.
- > VM programs comprise course of internationalization, research methodology course and a joint project, under the supervision of a mentor.
- > Courses also help in acquiring soft skills, increasingly valued by employers.



BLENDED MOBILITY

Blended mobility (BM) programs present a combination of virtual and real (physical) mobility.

- While VM programs are aimed at Master's and Bachelor students. our BM programs are aimed at PhD students.
- Participants have a chance to get familiar with innovative VM concept and spend time abroad working with their fellows and expanding mentors. their professional network internationally and thus improving their employability.
- > MILETUS blended mobility program consists of 3 phases:
- 1. First (virtual) phase is dedicated to the initiation of group work, definition of research topic and outcomes, literature review and method development.
- 2. Students spend the second (real) phase abroad at the host university conducting research and working closely with their peers and mentors.
- 3. Third (virtual) phase is focused on evaluation of the results and finalization of joint papers.
